



Updated COVID Response Plan Information – January 19, 2022

CHUMS will be following the recommendations from the San Antonio Metro Health Department for Early Childhood for any positive COVID cases we have in children. The following information is effective immediately and will take the place of the guidelines (under Health and Preventative Measures) within our COVID-19 Response Plan.

It is the recommendation of Metro Health that a child who tests positive remain home for 10 days, with day 1 beginning the first full day after symptoms or testing was completed.

If your child does test positive, notify CHUMS as soon as possible. We will need the date of testing and any symptoms your child is experiencing. We are required to report all cases, including that information, to the Health Department and Childcare Licensing.

If someone in your home tests positive or if your child (unvaccinated or not yet completed primary series of COVID vaccines) was exposed at school or outside of school, we will follow the CDC guidelines of quarantining for 5 days and testing at that time. As long as your child tests negative, they may return to school. A mask will be required for the 5 days following your child's return.

If your child has completed their primary series of COVID vaccines, there is no quarantine time necessary. It will be required for your child to wear a mask at school for the 10 days following exposure as well as get testing done after 5 days.

CHUMS does reserve the right to look at each case on an individual basis to determine the best course of action for our school.

You will always be notified if there is a positive case in your child's class. We use the Remind text notification system to do this.
